- Bank statement or certificate of balance signed by a bank official on official letter head indicating account opening date, average balance, and current balance.

THE INTERNATIONAL MASTER PROGRAM

In order to be considered for admission for Internationals Graduate applicants are expected to have a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in an appropriate fields (Electronic Engineering, Electrical Engineering or Computer Science) from an accredited educational institution. Students with a strong background in Engineering and a degree in Business are also encouraged to apply. Higher level students and experienced Engineers may also be enrolled.

The International Master Program Department is available to set up a personal interview if you need further information relating to the program and its relevance to your own career plans.

60 euros

APPLICATION DEADLINE

To allow enough time for application and visa processes, you should apply early.

July 31st is the latest date we will accept applications for the Fall Program. December 30th is the latest date we will accept applications for the Winter Program.

Programs start the first week of October for the Fall and the first week of March for Winter.

- 2 letters of recommendation in a sealed envelope and signed on the back,
- 1 certified copy of Bachelor's Degree and transcript of records, in original language as well as certified translations into French or English,
- TOEFL (minimum score 550 ITP, 213 CBT or 80 IBT) or TOEIC (minimum score 750) or IELTS (minimum score 6.0) or BULATS (minimum B2) (for all candidates from non English-speaking countries),
- Copy of passport,
- Application fee paid with money order or bank transfer,
- Bank or sponsor statement attesting that the student will have financial support throughout the duration of the program.

Nota: To be submitted after notification of admission.

TUITION FEES

Tuition fees are € 12,400 for the whole program (€ 3,600 for the first semester and € 8,800 for the two following semesters).

Fees do not include living expenses. Admitted applicants must make a deposit of € 5,500 to confirm their enrollment.

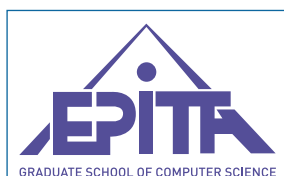
Students enrolled in the Harmonization Semester will redeem € 1,000 in tuition.
